Welcome to another edition of the **Printing Post**! Despite the summer heat and humidity, we praise God for blessing us with two solid months of production. We recommenced printing on the 10th of January, a week earlier than previously planned. We praise God for such dedicated and faithful volunteers!

During Jan & Feb 2006...

At the close of February, we have printed, guillotined, folded and packed some **774,000** tracts in Pidgin. Lord willing, once the shipping arrangements are in place, these tracts will be sent to **New Britain Island**. Missionaries **Bryan Girard** and **Ben Andrews** are the recipients and will distribute the tracts to the many independent Baptist churches and fellowships in that region of **Papua New Guinea**. Please pray with us for sufficient funds to come in to print and send a **million** tracts!

We have been inundated with "thank you" and pleas for more gospel tracts from **Filipino** churches after shipping some 2.4 million tracts to Cebu and Iligan since September 2005. Many of these requests come from very remote areas of **Cebu, Mindanao, Bohol** and **Negros**. Ps Ruben Sulapas, our distribution partner on Mindanao, reported that **more than 100**

churches have been helped in a short space of **four weeks!** We rejoice in the knowledge that our national partners are carrying out the distribution in an efficient and effective manner! Praise God for those who do the work that we cannot!



SBP Tracts - Bread with Life!

Missionary Graham Jackson recently sent me an email saying he has collected **30,000** tracts for his ministry in **Ozamis**. The Lord's

timing is perfect - Bro Graham had just run out of tracts when I invited him to contact Ps Ruben to get a fresh supply.

Having managed to secure **free freight** on half a shipping pallet, we despatched another **100,000** tracts to Cebu three weeks ago. Lord willing, they should arrive there late March.

It's not very often that we get the privilege to meet **Missionary Philippe Pinero** and **Nurse Jane Balgowan's** request for tracts. Since the literacy level is not high in **Vanuatu**, we were asked for tracts with pictures. We decided to "raid" Good Shepherd Baptist's stash of Chick tracts to fill this order.

Please pray for the ni-Van people to understand the gospel in **pictorial** form and be saved to a new life in Christ Jesus!

A case of mistaken identity?
