When we reached our target of a million tracts, to my surprise, the Lord said, "Stall the shipment!" A couple of weeks passed and the answer came in the form of a visit from Pastor Michael Saka of Tentsiti Baptist Church, Lae. During a great time of fellowship, I shared my

predicament with Pastor Saka. After hearing me out, Ps Saka described his country's major transport routes and explained how Lae is a much better gateway for distributing tracts to the many churches and preachers in Papua New Guinea.

Even with a better understanding under my belt, we still honoured our commitment to Missionaries Bryan Girard and Ben Andrews by sending them 513,000 tracts - 90% Pidgin, 10% English - in early April. Praise God for helping us complete our first major missions project for 2006!

We are now close to finishing our second project - supplying one million tracts to Pastor Saka, who will oversee the distribution into the Highlands, coastal regions and islands to the north.
