Thank you for praying for our Negros project! The container was delayed by more than 6 weeks and that allowed us to increase the consignment. On the 2nd of Nov, some 1,050,000 tracts left our premises destined for Negros & Cebu in the Philippines. Praise God!

Part of this shipment is consigned to Pastor Eddie Gerodias who will distribute the tracts to churches on Negros and surrounding islands.

To ensure that tracts reach the more remote areas, we arranged for many thousands to be packed into boxes with the pastors' names on them. Some country pastors are too shy to ask for tracts and it is often these preachers who need the most help.

Philippines Inland & Island Missions - a mission organisation with 20 years experience working with Philippine nationals - kindly assisted us with the packing and shipping. We thank God for giving us such helpful partners in the Gospel!

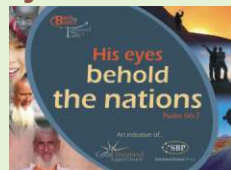
At the NBF conference...

doing a re-print until we receive orders totalling over 1000 sets, please email your order today to secure your sets.

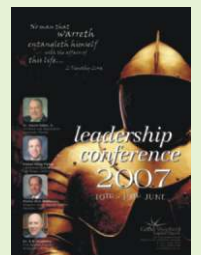
Over Nov & December...
