**Read the

Recent movies about Jesus Christ moved many people, while some were provoked to deep thought.

Movies may stimulate us to think about some things. God's book - the Bible - goes further and teaches us what God claims about Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son.

When reading the Bible, we see that...

A. People are sinners; Jesus was innocent. Yet, they killed Him.

Romans 3:23 tells us, *“For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;”*

You and I, in fact, everyone, have fallen short of Heaven because of our individual sin. Even telling a small lie is a sin by God's standards.

B. There are consequences for our actions.

Romans 6:23 states, *“For the wages of sin is death;...”*

The penalty for our sin is death - separation from God for eternity in a literal, burning Hell. There will be no exceptions; even 'good' or 'moral' people will die and be eternally separated from God because of their sins.

C. But, Jesus personally died for sinners.

Romans 5:8 declares, *“But God commendeth his*

love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.”

God loves us so much, and He proved that love by sending Jesus Christ, His sinless Son, to die in our place on the Cross. Jesus Christ was the perfect sacrifice; He paid the entire penalty for our sin.

D. However, God offers eternal life as a free gift to us.

Romans 6:23 explains, *“...the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”*

Forgiveness of sins and assurance of Heaven cannot be earned by good works or practising religion. Good works and religion without the Saviour will send us to Hell. Salvation is a gift, and a gift is free; it cannot be paid for by the receiver.

E. The best thing is, anyone can take this free gift.

Romans 10:13 states, *“For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”*

Only faith in Jesus Christ can save you from your sin. The 'whosoever' means you. Right now is the best time to take God at His Word, be saved, and be assured of a future home in Heaven.

No one can guarantee you will live till tomorrow to make such a decision. Now is the best time to decide your eternal destiny.
